#### 7. Unfinished Business

- a) <u>Destiny Church Update</u> Sloan spoke regarding the Destiny update and stated the hearing examiner approved as presented. There is no answer yet on if Oakridge is going to build the park. It has been reported that construction may start as early as this coming spring.

- d) New Office Sign Bids Management presented the new office sign bids as requested at the 08/20/14 Board meeting. - g) <u>Private Security Bids</u> The board discussed the security bid. The board authorizes Sloan Clack to contract WPD up to \$75,000, keeping in mind shift changes, insurance and flexible hours to change as needed.

- h) <u>Earth Tech Landscaping Proposal</u> The board reviewed and discussed Earth Tech's proposal. The board would like Earth Tech to be more pro-active next summer on watering the medians.

- i) <u>Deer Ridge Landscape Improvements</u> Discussed location and types of trees that would be planted.
- j) 2015 Reserve Study Ginelle suggested moving funds from The Arbors initial installment of cluster mailboxes into irrigation for the 2015 year which would bring the total to \$13,000. Management also suggested adding another \$10,000 to make the total \$23,000 which would not impact the homeowner contribution to the Reserves.
