- b) $\underline{2010-2011}$ Property Tax Appeals Update 2011 has been finalized at the reduced value of \$400.00 or less. The final decision for 2010 has not been made.

- 1. Destiny Church Property No Update.
- 2. 2012 Storm Clean Up Campbell's has completed six days at \$800.00 per day and is requesting a maximum of three more days at \$800 per day. Tony Sims suggests in the future that the Association requests performance contracts from vendors rather than hourly rate contracts.

3. Tanglewood Car Accident Fence Damage – Gina contacted the driver that damaged the fence. He has accepted responsibility for the damage, and signed a contract and payment plan to reimburse the Association for the damages. A payment of \$100.00 was made on February 14, 2012, with agreement to pay \$75.00 by the 15th of each month until the balance of \$612.81 is paid in full.

7. Unfinished Business

a) Security Bids/ Ideas for Entrance Ponds — Totem Electric amended their bid to include spot welding, motion sensor lighting and wire weights to further protect the electrical equipment. The total bid, not including sales tax, is \$9,364.00. The addition of large rocks placed over the junction boxes and a surveillance sign placed near the ponds was also proposed. Price for rocks, not including sales tax, is \$150.00 for three (two will be used at the junction boxes at entrance ponds; one will be used for junction box at North Rim Pond). The price for the surveillance sign, including sales tax is \$65.00.

8. New Business

a) <u>ARC/RCW Board Member Requirements</u> – Al Dawn has resigned from the Architectural Review Committee effective 03/15/2012. Gina Buchanan presented information that the RCW requires the ARC contain at least two Board members when the committee will be making decisions on behalf of the Board. Tom Boyle agreed to serve as the new ARC member.
